COLOMBIA

Overview: Colombia offers a remarkable mosaic of habitats, from Andean cloud forests to Amazonian floodplains, home to 2000 bird species and wildlife encounters. Community-based tourism and local guides showcase diverse ecosystems while supporting rural economies.

Seasonality: Best birding months vary by region; consider dry-season windows in Andean zones and the wet season for rainforest locales.

Highlights: Iconic species and photo opportunities across Colombia's biomes (eagles over Andean cliffs, colorful tanagers, hornbills in lowland forests, primates in riverine habitats, and spectacular macaws in the Amazon).

Typical Habitats: from the Paramos and high Andean forest above 12.000 ft, to the Amazon rainforest in the lowlands.

OUR TRIPS IN COLOMBIA



Colombia, Magic Andes.

Overview: A high-altitude, dramatic contrast landscape spanning cloud forests, páramo ecosystems, and snow-capped Andean peaks. This destination offers dramatic backdrops for birding and wildlife photography, from endemic high-elevation species to striking montane scenery.

Seasonality: Dry-season windows December through march and July to September.

Highlights: Endemic & high-elevation birds, panoramic mountain vistas, misty cloud forests, and opportunities for macro work among alpine flora.

Typical Habitats: Páramo, cloud forest, high-Andean forest.



OUR TRIPS IN COLOMBIA



Colombia, Santa Marta mountains and Caribe coastal region.

Overview: Explore the famed Sierra Nevada de Santa Marta region and adjacent ecosystems, offering a rich tapestry of cloud forests, and coastal habitats with abundant avian life.

Seasonality: Dry-season windows December through march and July to September.

Highlights: Many endemic and range restricted birds, several coastline migratory birds.

Typical Habitats: Tropical rainforest, cloud forest, dry forest and coastal mangroves.

Trip Links: Santa Marta: Sierra Nevada & Coastal Ridges

Colombia, Wildlife Safari.

Overview: A flexible wildlife-focused itinerary designed to showcase Colombia's diverse ecosystems - from rainforest pockets to lowland savannas - through immersive safaris, guided walks, and photography sessions.

Seasonality: only open from December through March

Highlights: Large mammals (where present), diverse birds, primates, and intimate wildlife encounters with community involvement.

Typical Habitats: Paramo, High Andean forest, eastern Andes foothills, wetlands, riverine habitats.

OUR TRIPS IN COLOMBIA



Colombia, Southern Colombia.

Overview: designed to watch and photograph birds and monkeys, including the Colombian massif, Andes region, Amazonian foothills and Amazon forest.

Seasonality: Dry-season windows December through march and July to September.

Highlights: more than 250 bird species and up to 8 monkey species possible.

Typical Habitats: Andean forest, Amazon foothills, Amazon forest.

BRAZIL

Overview: Brazil is undoubtedly one of world's top birds and wildlife destinations, being home of 1800 bird species and tons of mammals and cats. Embark yourself on a journey to enjoy magnificent creatures in their natural habitats

Seasonality: Best season vary by region; consider June to September for Atlantic forest and Pantanal and December to March for Northeast

Highlights: Iconic species and photo opportunities across Brazil biomes, including the most important neotropical hotspot for birds endemism, the Atlantic forest

Typical Habitats: Pantanal (wetlands and rivers), Cerrado (tropical savanna), Amazon rain forest, Atlantic forest and the Caatinga.

OUR TRIPS BRAZIL



Brazil, Atlantic forest.

Overview: A lush, biodiverse tropical biome along Brazil's eastern coast, the Atlantic Forest hosts a mosaic humid forest, wetlands and coastal serranias. This destination offers tons of endemic and near endemic birds, lush landscape and plenty photography opportunities amid a landscape that ranges from lowland forest trails to misty hilltops.

Seasonality: Dry-season windows June to September

Highlights: highest number in endemic birds of the neotropics.

Typical Habitats: Humid sub-tropical forest

Trip Links: Atlantic forest

Brazil, Jaguar experience.

Overview: An immersive wildlife-focused itinerary centered on jaguar habitats and activity in Brazil's premier conservation regions. The route combines rainforest immersion, riverine landscapes, and treetop vantage points to maximize chances for iconic jaguar sightings and captivating wildlife photography, along with broader photography opportunities in tropical ecosystems.

Seasonality: Peak jaguar activity often correlates with dry seasons: June to September

Highlights: Jaguar and wildlife excellent viewing opportunities, high diversity of birds, mammals, and reptiles

Typical Habitats: Savannas, gallery forest, wetlands and grasslands

OUR TRIPS BRAZIL



Brazil, Pantanal adventure.

Overview: A pristine wetlands-focused itinerary in the Pantanal, Brazil's vast seasonally flooded plains. This route emphasizes in photography opportunities of mammals (giant otters, jaguars, Anteater, Maned Wolf among others) and birds in a dynamic aquatic landscapes. Expect open savanna-like vistas interwoven with channels, lagoons, and forest patches that host a rich biodiversity.

Seasonality: best time is the dry seasons: June to September

Highlights: breathtaking wildlife, areas loaded with birds.

Typical Habitats: Savannas, gallery forest, wetlands and grasslands

Trip Links: Pantanal Adventure

Brazil, Northeast.

Overview: A coastal-to-inland mosaic of Brazil's Northeast, capturing diverse ecosystems from the Caatinga dry forest remnants to arid sertão landscapes and cerrado tropical savanna. This destination offers isolated endemic birds of Brazil most threatened biomes.

Seasonality: best time from November to March

Highlights: focus on endemic very range restricted birds

Typical Habitats: dry forest, tropical savannas.

Trip Links: Northeast of Brazil
